
LAMINATE PANEL DETAILS

Panels are available in two widths: **600mm** or **1200mm** and are **2440mm** in height. Choose from Square Cut panels or take advantage of our Proclick technology which achieves seamless joints without the need for joining trims.




Note: All panels are available with a plywood core on request, made to order. A minimum order quantity of 5 panels applies.



All Laminate panels are 10.5mm in thickness.

Square Cut are easy-to-cut panels making installation and maintenance simple. This durable system utilises hygienic trims to join together and seal panels in place of traditional, often time consuming, grouting.

Proclick technology has been engineered to create a mechanical locking system that provides seamless, almost invisible joints. Installation is made easy through the click design which allows panels to be located quickly and easily into place, eliminating the use of joining trims.




ACCESSORIES

Our trims and Sureseal are available in a range of colours to suit every decor, supported by Showerwall's own brand of sealant and adhesive which have been engineered to ensure lasting results.


TRIMS

In order to ensure a watertight finish, trims are required for the outer edges of the panels, as well as both internal and external corners. Four trims are available dependant on where you would like to fit our panels. All of our trims measure **2450mm** in length and should be sealed using Showerwall sealant.

MATERIAL

Face laminates are produced to EN 438 standard (VGS) and are bonded to a quality quality FSC® certified Exterior Grade MDF core using adhesive applied under strictly controlled conditions. A balancing backing laminate is then bonded to the panel reverse.

FIRE RATINGS / PERFORMANCE

All Showerwall panels are classified EN 13501-1. In addition, selected decors are British Standard Fire Rated Class 2-BS 476: Part 7:1997. Test reports are available upon request. Fire ratings relate specifically to the product when tested in laboratory conditions and do not confirm suitability for the intended application. The responsibility lies with the specifier or user of the product to ensure its ultimate suitability for the intended end use application.

PRIOR TO INSTALLATION

Panels must be stored flat on level height bearers within a normally heated room environment. All panels must be inspected carefully before installation. Any concerns raised must be clarified prior to installation.

COMPACT PANEL DETAILS

Our Compact panels are made from a strong solid composite material, embossed to create a tile effect wall without the need for grout. These 3mm solid laminate panels are easy to fit as part of a waterproof system, reducing the fitting time compared with traditional tile products - and they are even easier to keep clean.



Panels are 1220mm wide, 2440mm in height and are square cut.




ACCESSORIES

We recommend that Showerwall's own brand of adhesive and sealants are used for the effective fitting of panels to walls, and sealing between them respectively. Our Showerwall guarantee only applies if the correct products are used when fitting Showerwall panels.

Showerwall Compact laminate is **3mm thick** high pressure laminate that is produced to EN 438 standards.

All Showerwall Compact panels are classified BS EN13501: 2007 +Al : 2009 with a fire rating of C, sl, d0.

PRIOR TO INSTALLATION

Panels must be stored flat on level height bearers within a normally heated room environment. All panels must be inspected carefully before installation. Any concerns raised must be clarified prior to installation.





Consciously manufactured


We use a cold bonding press when manufacturing our panels which uses less energy than a traditional hot press. In addition our acrylic printer no longer uses UV ink, which previously required the use of ventilation and safety equipment due to the release of odours and airborne chemicals into the atmosphere.





Eco-friendly head office

The Showerwall Head Office & Factory site is a sustainable building, including solar panels, LED & passive lighting, electric vehicle charging points and it uses green energy. We also operate electric forklifts in the factory.



Recycle & reuse

We recycle and refill the storage containers our bonding glue and acrylic printer ink is kept in. The cardboard we use for packaging is made from recycled materials and is fully recyclable. Any panel off cuts and factory dust are separated and sent to a biomass recycling station.
